Categories

Eye Norwegian Junior Open 2020 is open to players, girls and boys, of any nationality under the age of 19, 17, 15 and 13 (due to national regulations foreign players can participate from Jan 1st the year they turn 11) on the final day of the tournament, provided the player is not banned under the <u>ESF Junior</u> <u>Circuit Guidelines</u> section C.4 or E.4.

There will be a maximum draw of 64 players per category. The TD reserves the right to amalgamate age groups if there are insufficient entries to make a workable draw. Players are only allowed to enter one category.

















European Squash ID (ESID)

All players, coaches, managers and other officials must be registered with ESF. This must be approved and validated by the relevant MNF. The MNF is responsible for ensuring that all players, coaches, managers and other officials are registered with ESF prior to entry, and their entry is fully supported.

Coaches

Coaches: All team or individual player coaches designated by their Nation as part of their event onsite management team(solely or in attendance with an appointed team manager) at any Championship held under the auspices of ESF must be ESF registered, i.e. have an ESID, as their licence to attend as a formal representative. This is required at the time of them being registered to attend by their National federation.

Seeding

The seeding will be carried out using the European Junior Ranking valid at the closing date. Any non-European players without an ESF Junior Ranking will be seeded by the Tournament Director.

Matches

All matches played will consist of the best of five games, under the rules of the WSF. All players are guaranteed a minimum of three matches. PAR 11 scoring (to 2 clear points) will be used.

Draws

The seeding lists and time of the first matches for specific age groups will be published at least 5 days prior to the start date, or alternatively a date and time for all participants to report to the TD will be stated.

Refereeing

Both players will be expected to mark and referee matches.

Clothing

Players must wear suitable squash attire including non-marking shoes.

Eye Protection

It is mandatory for approved eye protection to be worn at all times during competition play, including the knock up at this event. Players will not be allowed to compete without approved eye protection.

















Recording of matches/Web Publishing/Live Streaming

The recording of matches for coaching/performance analysis purposes is acceptable provided the player and/or their parents/coaches do not object. The streaming will be published at YouTube and/or at Facebook.

The Junior Open will be publishing draws, results, photos of players as well as live streaming.

Prizes

There will be prize money awarded in the U19 boys and girls categories. In all other categories, there will be gift/trophies or gift prizes.

Insurance

Players enter and play in the tournament at their own risk. Neither the organisers nor the ESF will accept responsibility for any claims including for injury or accident. Suitable insurance must be organised by the player or the participating federation.

Entries

All entries must be endorsed by the players National Association. To enter the tournament use the official online entry form which will be available at https://squash.no/eve-norwegian-junior-open-2020/ from 1th February 2020.

Safeguarding, health and safety

Adults interacting with juniors in the organisation and running of ESF Junior Circuit events are in a position of trust and influence. ESF Regulations & Penalties

The tournament is part of the ESF Junior Circuit and will be run in accordance with the ESF Junior Guidelines, a copy of which is available on the ESF website www.europeansquash.com. MNFs should make sure that all relevant people (including coaches, managers and players) are aware of the Guidelines and their requirements. The tournament will be run under the terms and conditions as set out in ESF Regulations: Code of Conduct - The tournament will be run under the terms and conditions as set out in EUROPEAN SQUASH FEDERATION PRIVACY POLICY as published on the ESF website www.europeansquash.com A late withdrawal is a withdrawal made 2 days or less before the start date of the tournament. If a player: a) Has entered a tournament and fails to turn up, he/she will receive zero ranking points for the tournament b) Fails to play out all scheduled matches for any reason other than illness or injury, he/she may receive zero ranking points for the tournament c) If zero points are awarded the points will count as one of the players 4 best results for the rolling 12 month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically d) Commits either of these offence for a second time within a 12 month period, he/she will be banned from the ESF Juniors Circuit for a period of 12 months

















Transport information

From Airport to Lysaker squash center:

You can fly to Oslo Airport (Gardermoen), and from there you can get the train directly to Lysaker station, see <u>link</u> (it takes approximately 30 min). There is a 2 min walk from Lysaker train station to Lysaker squash Center.

1) **Picture 1** - walk between Lysaker squash center and Lysaker station:

Description: Once you exit the train, walk down the stairs and walk across towards the bus stops. You will pass Narvesen on your left hand side and Vitus Pharmacy on your right. Walk across the road and up the stairs ahead. Once at the top you walk up a small set of stairs again and then keep straight. Walk between the two buildings and you will soon see Lysaker Squash in front of you.



2 min (160 m)

From Lysaker squash center and Lysaker train/bus station (bus station is just across the road from Lysaker train station - see picture 3) to Scandic Fornebu hotel:

You can easily travel between venue and Scandic Fornebu by bus (see picture 1 for walk between Lysaker squash center and Lysaker bus station)

From Lysaker bus station, you can get different buses, such as 31, 31E or 24. The bus takes approximately 9-12 min and you get off at "IT Fornebu" bus station. From there you walk 200-400m to the hotel. See **picture2**: <u>googlemap link</u>
