CATEGORIES

Open to players of any nationality under the age of 13, 15, 17 and 19 on the final day of the tournament provided the player is not banned under the ESF Junior Circuit Guidelines
max. 32 players in each category

MATCHES & SCORING

All matches will be played as best of five games, under the rules of the WSF.
PAR scoring to 11 will be used at all tournaments on the ESF Junior Circuit (to 2 clear points).
All players are guaranteed a minimum of 3 matches.

SEEDING

Seeding will be carried out using the ESF Junior Rankings valid at the closing date and in accordance with the ESF Junior Circuit Guidelines. Details of the seeding and timings will be sent to participating member nations at least 7 days before the start of the event.

TRANSPORT

Transport will be provided from Belgrade Airport and the train stations in Belgrade.
Participants will only be picked up if they notify the tournament organisers of their arrival times before 25th Sept 2017.
The transport from club to the hotel is also included.

INSURANCE

Players enter and play in the tournament at their own risk. Neither the organisers nor the ESF accept any responsibility for injury arising from participating in the event.

Players must arrange their own insurance. All players have to wear approved protective eye guards on court

EYE GUARDS

All competitors at ESF approved Junior tournaments must wear approved protective eye guards, manufactured to an appropriate national safety standard, properly over the eyes at all times during competition play. This includes the knock-up. It is the responsibility of the player to ensure that the quality of the product is satisfactory for the purpose. Players will not be allowed to compete without this protection. See the WSF website – www.worldsquash.org – for approved eye guards.

GUIDELINES

This event complies with the European Squash Federation Junior Circuit Guidelines – a copy of which is available on the ESF website at www.europeansquash.com. All participating member nations should make sure that all relevant people (including coaches, managers and players) are aware of the Guidelines and their requirements.

The recording of matches for coaching / performance analysis purposes is acceptable provided the player and / or their parents / coaches do not object

REFEREEING

All players will be expected to mark and referee matches.

BALL

The Dunlop Pro ball will be used.

PRIZES

Trophies for top three players in all categories.

ENTRIES

All entries must be made through / endorsed by the relevant national federation.

Any entry not endorsed by a player's national federation will not be accepted.

All entries will be acknowledged. Details of the centre, hotel and travel information will be sent to entrants or their association by e-mail.

ENTRY / PACKAGE FEE

- Tournament package 1: € 235 per person, including entry fee, 3 nights accommodation meals from Thursday evening to Sunday morning.
Full transportation between hotel, airport and the club.
- Tournament package 2: € 190 per person, including entry fee, 2 nights accommodation meals from Friday lunch time to Sunday morning.
Full transportation between hotel, airport and the club.
- Single room supplement: € 15 per person per night
- Extra night: € 35 in a double room, per person per night; € 50 in a single room per person per night
- Entry Fee without package: € 46 (includes tournament T-Shirt)

SPIN - All players must have an active, paid for SPIN (Squash Personal Identification Number) to participate.

In the event of a withdrawal, fees will be reimbursed as follows:

- Withdrawal up to 2 weeks before start date: fees will be reimbursed in full less all bank charges
- Withdrawal 3-14 days before the start date: 50% of fee less all bank charges
- Withdrawal 2 days, or less before the start date: any reimbursement will be at the discretion of the Tournament Organiser.

WITHDRAWALS

The following penalties will apply, in accordance with the ESF Junior Guidelines:

E.4. a) If a player makes a late withdrawal from a tournament (2 days or less before the start date), a doctor's certificate confirming injury/illness must be provided to avoid penalties. The medical certificate (with a translation in English) must clearly state the player's name, date of birth and the nature of the illness/injury; the certificate must cover the date of the relevant tournament and must be sent to the ESF office within two days after the final day of the tournament (email: info@europeansquash.com; fax +44 1675 443440). Any player making a late withdrawal not supported by a medical certificate will receive zero points for the tournament which will count as one of their 4 best results for the rolling 12 month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically unless the ESF office receives a doctor's certificate within two days of the final day of the tournament.

If a player commits this offence for a second time within a 12 month period, he/she will be banned from the ESF Junior Circuit for a period of 12 months.

b) If a player has entered a tournament and fails to turn up, he/she will receive zero ranking points for the tournament. These zero points will count as one of the player's 4 best results for the rolling 12 month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically.

If a player commits this offence for a second time within a 12 month period, he/she will be banned from the ESF Junior Circuit for a period of 12 months.

c) If a player fails to play out all scheduled matches for any reason other than illness or injury, he/she will receive zero ranking points for the tournament. Illness or injury must be verified by the tournament director and, if possible, by medical certificate sent to the ESF office within two days of the final day of the tournament. If zero points are awarded, the points will count as one of the player's 4 best results for the rolling 12 month period and will be taken into account when dividing the points to obtain the ranking average. This penalty will be applied automatically. If a player commits this offence for a second time within a 12 month period, he/she will be banned from the ESF Junior Circuit for a period of 12 months.
